

Will he delay long in helping them? <i>Luke 18:7-8</i></p> <p>Collect Mighty God, strong loving and wise, help us to depend upon your goodness and to place our trust in your Son; who is alive and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God for ever. Amen.</p>	<p><u>23 October 2022 – 30th ordinary</u></p> <p>Liturgy: 8am NZPB Pg 404 9am Euch Belmont 10am Family Eucharist Colour: Green</p> <p>Readings: Joel 2:23-32 Luke 18:9-14</p> <p>Sentence: Truly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God like a child shall not enter it. <i>Luke 18:17</i></p> <p>Collect: Jesus our Lord, you have taught us that judgement begins at the house of God; save us from our self-satisfaction, rigidity and corruption, so that we may stand ready to do your will; for the glory of your holy name. Amen.</p>
<p><u>30 October 2022 – All Saints</u></p> <p>Liturgy: 8am NZPB Pg 404 9am Euch Belmont 10am Family Eucharist Colour: White</p> <p>Readings: Hebrews 1:1-4; 2:1-4 Luke 19:1-10</p> <p>Sentence: God's love has been poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit who has been given to us." <i>Romans 5:5b</i></p> <p>Collect: Father, you have filled you people with the Spirit who rested first on your Son and united us in your Church; open the channels for your Spirit that we may freely work together, so that your kingdom and your rule may increase. Amen.</p>	<p><u>6 November 2022- 32nd Ordinary</u></p> <p>Liturgy: 8am NZPB Pg 404 9am MW Belmont 10am Family Eucharist 5pm Evensong Colour: Green</p> <p>Readings: Haggai 1:15b-2:9 Luke 20:27-38</p> <p>Sentence 'I am the resurrection and the life,' says the Lord. 'Those who believe in me, even though they die, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die.' <i>John 11:25-26</i></p> <p>Collect: Almighty God, you have sent the Spirit of your Son into our hearts and set us free from the bondage of sin; give us grace to dedicate our freedom to your service, that we and all your people may be brought to the glorious liberty of the children of God; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen</p>

<p><u>13 November 2022 – Christ in Creation</u></p> <p>Liturgy: 8am NZPB Pg 404 9am Eucharist Belmontt 10am Family Eucharist Colour: Green</p> <p>Readings: Genesis 1:1-19 Mark 16:14-20</p> <p>Sentence: Jesus said “ Go into all the world and proclaim the god news to all creation.”</p> <p>Collect: Gracious God, the source of all good, you have provided the resources of the world to maintain the life of your children, and have so ordered our life that we are dependent on one another; bless all people in their daily work, and as you have given us the knowledge to produce plenty, so give us the will to make it available to all; through Jesus Christ our Saviour. Amen</p>	<p><u>20 November 2022 – Christ the King</u></p> <p>Liturgy: 8am NZPB Pg 404 9am MW Belmont 10am Family Eucharist Colour: White</p> <p>Readings: Jeremiah: 4 23:1-6 Luke 23:33-43</p> <p>Sentence: I say to the Lord, “You are my Lord, I have no good apart from you.” <i>Psalm 16:2</i></p> <p>Collect: Grant to your people, O God, the boldness of your Holy Spirit, that those who follow your Son may do so without condition or compromise, in the assurance of faith and in loving compassion. We ask this through your Son our Saviour Jesus Christ. Amen.</p>
<p><u>27 November 2022 – Advent 1</u> All in service</p> <p>Liturgy: 8am NZPB Pg 404 10am All in ServiceFamily Eucharist Colour: Violet</p> <p>Readings: 1 Thessalonians 3:9-13 Luke 21:25-36</p> <p>Sentence Stand up and raise your heads; your redemption is drawing near. <i>Luke 21:28</i></p> <p>Collect: Come, O come Emmanuel, you are the way, the truth and the life; Come, living Saviour come to your world which waits for you. Hear this prayer for your love’s sake. Amen.</p>
