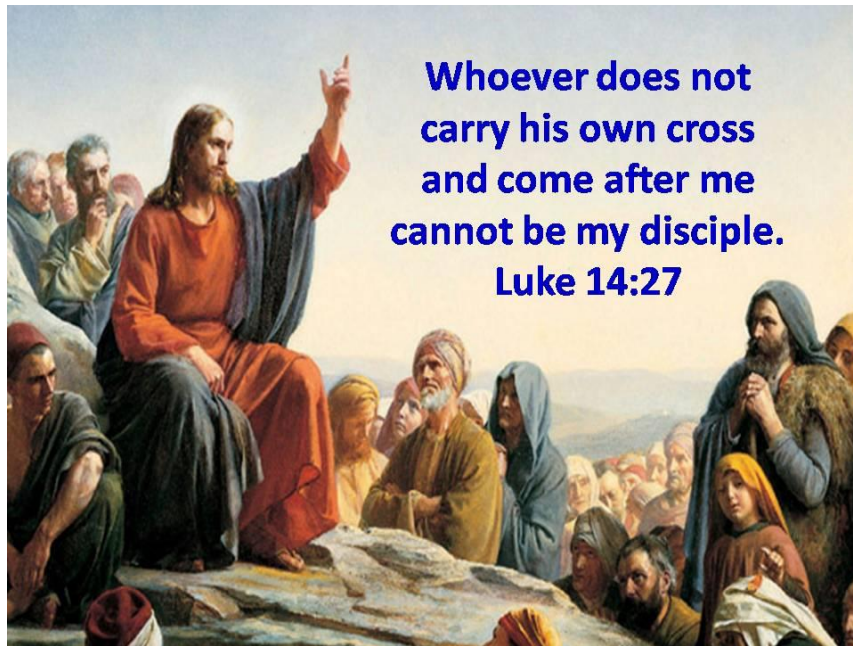

One of the first policies we have been working on is that of sensitive expenditure and financial delegations.

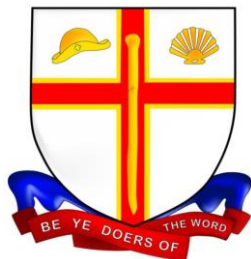
We are keen to share with you the principles we have adopted as part of that process and new policy document. You will note that the principles come as a package and no one principle is more important than the other.

We adopt the following principles to underpin our decision making on expenditure.

Expenditure decisions should:

- have a justifiable business purpose
- preserve impartiality
- be made with integrity
- be moderate and conservative
- be made transparently
- be made with proper authority

No one principle should be treated as more important than any other.
