


## Hall Upgrade - Update


#### **Donations Received**

We now have a total of **\$67,550 donations**, being \$58,550 committed; and \$9,000 qualified (refundable if the project doesn't proceed).

#### That is an increase of another \$10,150 since last week!

This is getting to be really exciting!! Our continuing thanks to all the donors for their support.







#### How will donors be benefitted?

- Option of having names of donors; or for memorial donations, names of nominated family members or friends; to be displayed on a Donations Plaque for donations over \$2,000
- Tax refunds of 33% can be available on charitable donations. That means for every \$1,000 donated, up to \$330 may be given back by IRD.
- Upgraded venue available to all for family gatherings, fellowship and church events.
- Knowledge we are better able to undertake our church's mission and help our community (eg in a disaster with emergency accommodation) with upgraded facilities generally.
- Upgraded safety and increased comfort when compliance issues (kitchen, toilets, fire egress and earthquake strengthening) have been dealt with.
