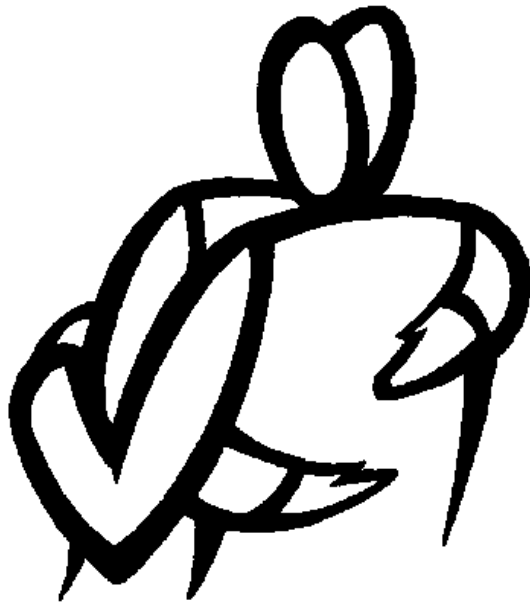

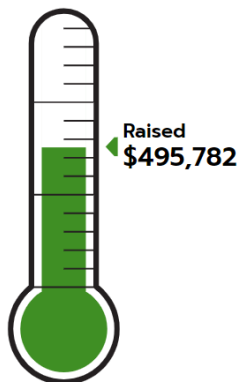

We expect the results of our applications in mid-December.

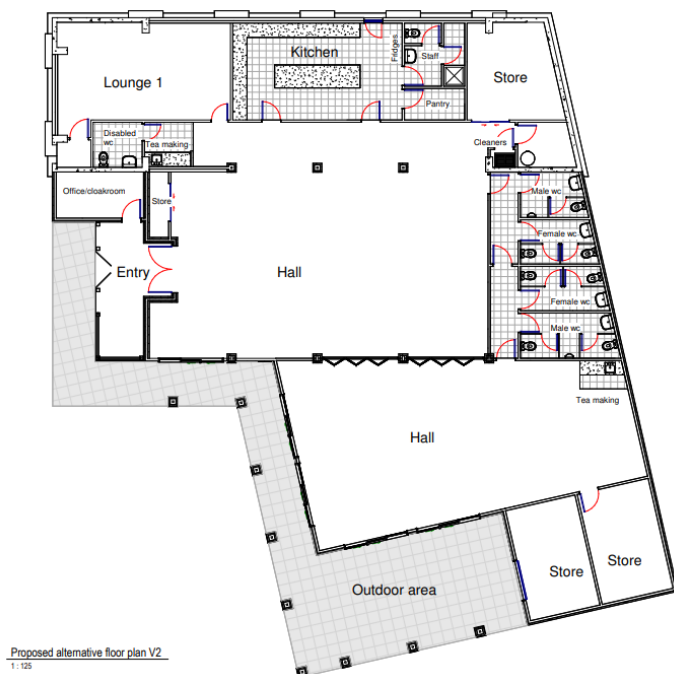
