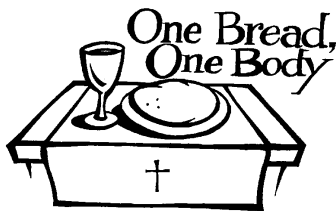

The Common Cup is offered to all at our communion services. You may decline a sip if you do not want drink from this cup.

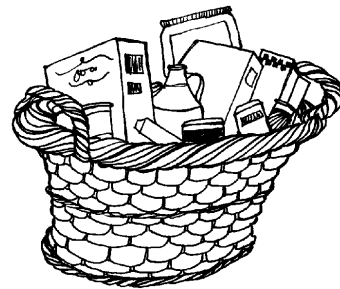
