



### Lower Hutt Foodbank Donations annual report

After the parish AGM each year, we report to the Anglican Centre (the Diocese of Wellington's Administrative Centre) the amount of food we donate to our local food bank in the past 12 months.

We are pleased to report that last year the parish donated approximately \$163 of food and health products per week.

When we multiply that figure by 52 weeks of the year **that is a total of \$8,476!** That's a generous gift to our local community in this high cost-of-living time.
